Our extraordinary story began in 1919, when our founder Eglantyne Jebb launched the pioneering fight to save suffering children across war-torn Europe, which soon inspired a global movement. She was the first person to declare the rights of the child and demand the world take responsibility to ensure those rights were realized. A hundred years later, Save the Children continues to be driven by the same clear and compelling vision, courage and compassion.



Our programs span 120 countries and six continents. Save the Children is the first international NGO allowed in Vietnam after the fall of Saigon. In 1989, the UN adopts the Convention on the Rights of the Child, which was based on Jebb's vision for children. We are at the forefront of global efforts to reduce maternal and child mortality.
