SURVEY ON STUDENTS' LEARNING AND WELLBEING DURING COVID-19 SCHOOL SUSPENSION IN HONG KONG



RESEARCH OBJECTIVES

I) Determine the most common difficulties Hong Kong children face with remote learning during school suspension and how students think they could overcome them.

2) Get children's perspectives on their wellbeing during the school suspension and the things that affect it most.


3) Get children's perspectives on what support they need for and their feelings about their return to school.

SAMPLING METHOD AND LIMITATIONS


The sample frame for this survey is children in Hong Kong of school attending age. The sampling method was a combination of convenience sampling and snowball sampling. The survey collected responses between May 9th, 2020 and May 22nd, 2020. A total of 274 valid responses were received. Survey recruitment was open to children of all ages but the primary target group was secondary school students on account of the greater ease of inviting secondary school children to complete the survey through social media advertisements and organization referral networks. Approximately 54% of respondents were reached through sharing the survey link with the Save the Children Youth Ambassador network and other organization professional networks, 18% were reached through Save the Children staff referring the survey to children known to them, 16% of respondents were reached through snowball referral from another survey respondent, and 12% were reached through Instagram advertisements. These sampling methods were selected to ensure quick respondent recruitment to enable rapid completion of the study and timely sharing of results. The limitation of the sampling method is that the results will not be representative of the entire Hong Kong student population, and many younger students were not able to be reached. The survey included reader-friendly consent statements for parents and children, while no sensitive questions were asked and the survey responses were collected anonymously via an online survey platform.



9. What type of learning materials do you use now that schools are closed? (you can choose more than one option)






